On Saturday, Nov. 4, the <u>Sonoma-Tokaj Sister Cities</u> hosted "The Music of Zoltán Kodály" at Burlingame Hall in Sonoma. Organized by János Horváth (<u>KFME Honorary Board</u>), this event was an enjoyable afternoon of entertainment and education.

The afternoon began with wine and cheese, with a choice of round tables or audience seating for the presentation. János Horváth gave an entertaining and informative talk about Kodály the ethnomusicologist, educator and composer, accompanied by a wonderful slideshow compiled by Ebolya Ligotti. Also included was a teaching demonstration with the guest children's choir <u>Young Musicians Chorus</u> (YMC) and audience members.

Marni Strome (KFME Board) spoke about her experience as a student in the summer school and masters programs at the Kodály Center at Holy Names, and how this education had changed her life as a musician and teacher.

<u>Betsy Marvit</u>, (Artistic Director YMC), Betsy Marvitt and János Horváth encouraged audience singing through a demonstration of solfége and other tools of music education inspired by the Kodály approach.

The Young Musicians Chorus then sang for the audience, which included all singing "Esti Dal" (Zoltán Kodály). The afternoon was rounded off beautifully with a stellar piano performance by <u>Dr. Hyunjoo Chung</u>, who played Kodály's "Marosszeki Tancok" ("Dances of Marosszek").
